TERMS & CONDITIONS & POLICIES & PROCEDURES FOR DAY BOARDING

Viewing before booking

Appointments available on a Sunday, subject to availability.

Booking & Deposits

A non-refundable £50 of your booking fee is payable to secure your booking, send via what's app the completed booking form filled out including a photo of proof of vaccines (a copy for our records).

Drop off & Collection Times

Appointment is only for either 0800, 12.30 or 15.00. These times can be negotiable under certain circumstances, please ask for availability.

Late collections

If you arrive after 8AM the day is then charged for. If you are held up that is no problem but please contact me to arrange a new day / time (charges apply for extra days).

Bedding

Bedding is provided although you can bring your dog's own blanket because it will be comforting to have familiar smells. We cannot accept responsibility for destroyed belongings.

Specific Information

Please ensure any information you feel is relevant is passed on via your booking form even if you think it's minor. This will give us the best interests of your dog in my care. Information could include:

- Dietary requirements
- Medication
- If your dog is friendly to children / adults / other dogs • Your dog's favourite toy / game / treat

Feeding

We provide bowls. You will provide your own dog's food; this keeps your dog's diet the same to ensure no diet changes causing digestive upset. Dogs will be fed in their own space by themselves.

Cancellations

You must give at least 2 weeks' notice to cancel your booking or payment must be made in full as we hold this space for you. Deposits are non-refundable.

Attendance

There is a minimum attendance of 3 boarding days per booking, this is also for day boarding per week.

Payments

Payments are to be made on the first day of the month for the previous month for day boarding.

Payments for holidays are to be made before or on arrival.

Well, being

Unhealthy dogs will be turned away. Apologies but I must keep infection and disease away from the premises.

If your dog becomes unwell whilst staying here, I will call our emergency vet (The Mobile Emergency Vet) if your emergency contact can't collect your dog will be held in an isolation at Darlington Vet Clinic until fit or collected by your emergency contact. Your dog will be monitored by the Vets. Costs to be covered by the owner.

Immature Dogs (puppies & dogs under one year) Puppies to be kept in a quiet area to minimise stress and disruption to routine.

Escape

On arrival your dog will have an identity tag fitted to their collar with my details on. This is just a precaution in case your dog slips their lead or gets spooked and runs out of the premises. This will help get your dog back to me while you're away from home. The dog warden and Animal Welfare will be notified to help get your dog back safely. (Please note that this is a precaution)

Introducing new dogs to existing group of dog's new dogs are to be introduced to the existing group of dogs when there are two people present. This is only to be done if consent has been given via the booking form and signed for.

Bio Security / Infection control / Cleaning regimes All kennels, runs, hallways, bedding & bowls will be cleaned daily with disinfectants. Dogs will not be present while this is happening. Areas will be dried off and bedding to be washed & changed ready for your dog for the rest of the day. Kennels will also be cleaned as and when required in between. No dog will be left in a dirty / wet kennel. Colour coordinated mops & buckets are used to clean different types of mess. Hot water / hand washing facilities are always available. Virkon (Disinfectant) will be used on site, this is an animal friendly disinfectant. Protective clothing (disposable aprons, gloves and shoe protectors) to be worn in isolation areas to prevent spread of any infection / disease.

Deaths

If your dog passes away (due to old age) while in our care, we can arrange one of the following for you do:

1. Your dog to be collected by your vets or dropped by myself to your vet so they can keep your dog until you decide what to do with the body at your expense.
2. Your dog to be collected by Forget Me Not Pet Crematorium at your expense or as a family member.
3. If your dog dies unexpectedly whilst in our care, we will contact you or your emergency contact, and we can arrange to send your dog to Farm Postmortems (Bishop Auckland) for further investigation upon your request at your expense.

If your dog escapes, I will notify the council dog warden giving all relative information. Every endeavor will be undertaken to locate your dog should this happen.

Abandonment

If you do not collect your dog within 7 days of pick-up date, I will presume you have abandoned your dog I will try to contact you every day and if there is no reply or contact I will have to proceed with legal action.

Transportation

Your dog will be in a suitably sized crate positioned in the back of the vehicle, with suitable ventilation (windows partially open to suit the dog). The crate will be disinfected after each use. No dogs will be left unattended at any time whilst being transported.

- All exercise and play routines are tailored to the individual dogs needs and requirements such as age, ability and general preference.
- We have two secure exercise fields and smaller areas so that your dog can enjoy some time off their lead. We also have 10 acres of grass land to walk around.
- We like to keep to this schedule to prevent dogs getting bored. It is also great for dogs who suffer with anxiety as they soon settle into the routine of someone coming for them regularly.
 - Any special requirements or routines can be adapted in, this is just our routine.
- All rooms have an inside and outside covered facility available to all dogs. If the weather isn't very nice we can close the dogs in upon request.
- All rooms have heating and underfloor heating and can be individually set to whatever temperature your dog is comfortable at.
- We take videos and photos throughout your dog's stay and we can send them onto you as and when. This can ease your mind knowing your dogs are having a lovely time and are settled.
